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19 I, the undersigned, say, on information and belief, that in
20 the County of Yolo, State of California:

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22 Count 1 : On or about February 21, 2016, ERNEST LANE
23 MORALES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Sections
24 21a, 664(a) and 187(a) of the California Penal Code, ATTEMPTED
25 MURDER, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES did willfully, unlawfully
26 and with malice aforethought attempt to murder S.S. age 56, a
27 human being.

28 Count Enhancement 1a : It is further alleged that the

1 attempted murder alleged above was willful, deliberate and
2 premeditated within the meaning of California Penal Code
3 Sections 664(a) and 189, ENHANCEMENT FOR WILLFUL, DELIBERATE AND
4 PREMEDITATED ATTEMPTED MURDER.

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6 Count 2 : On or about February 21, 2016, ERNEST LANE
7 MORALES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Sections
8 21a, 664(a) and 187(a) of the California Penal Code, ATTEMPTED
9 MURDER, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES did willfully, unlawfully
10 and with malice aforethought attempt to murder S.S. age 23, a
11 human being.

12 Count Enhancement 2a : It is further alleged that the
13 attempted murder alleged above was willful, deliberate and
14 premeditated within the meaning of California Penal Code
15 Sections 664(a) and 189, ENHANCEMENT FOR WILLFUL, DELIBERATE AND
16 PREMEDITATED ATTEMPTED MURDER.

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18 Count 3 : On or about February 21, 2016, ERNEST LANE
19 MORALES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Sections
20 21a, 664(a) and 187(a) of the California Penal Code, ATTEMPTED
21 MURDER, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES did willfully, unlawfully
22 and with malice aforethought attempt to murder A.S. age 5, a
23 human being.

24 Count Enhancement 3a : It is further alleged that the
25 attempted murder alleged above was willful, deliberate and
26 premeditated within the meaning of California Penal Code
27 Sections 664(a) and 189, ENHANCEMENT FOR WILLFUL, DELIBERATE AND
28 PREMEDITATED ATTEMPTED MURDER.

1 Count 4 : On or about February 21, 2016, ERNEST LANE
2 MORALES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Sections
3 21a, 664(a) and 187(a) of the California Penal Code, ATTEMPTED
4 MURDER, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES did willfully, unlawfully
5 and with malice aforethought attempt to murder J.S. age 3, a
6 human being.

7 Count Enhancement 4a : It is further alleged that the
8 attempted murder alleged above was willful, deliberate and
9 premeditated within the meaning of California Penal Code
10 Sections 664(a) and 189, ENHANCEMENT FOR WILLFUL, DELIBERATE AND
11 PREMEDITATED ATTEMPTED MURDER.

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13 Count 5 : On or about February 21, 2016, ERNEST LANE
14 MORALES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Sections
15 21a, 664(a) and 187(a) of the California Penal Code, ATTEMPTED
16 MURDER, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES did willfully, unlawfully
17 and with malice aforethought attempt to murder Z.S. unknown age,
18 a human being.

19 Count Enhancement 5a : It is further alleged that the
20 attempted murder alleged above was willful, deliberate and
21 premeditated within the meaning of California Penal Code
22 Sections 664(a) and 189, ENHANCEMENT FOR WILLFUL, DELIBERATE AND
23 PREMEDITATED ATTEMPTED MURDER.

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25 Count 6 : On or about February 21, 2016, ERNEST LANE
26 MORALES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section
27 451(b) of the California Penal Code, ARSON OF AN INHABITED
28 STRUCTURE, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES did willfully,

1 unlawfully, and maliciously set fire to and burn and cause to be
2 burned and did aid, counsel and procure the burning of an
3 inhabited structure and inhabited property.

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5 Case Enhancement a : It is further alleged that ERNEST LANE
6 MORALES was previously convicted of a serious felony within the
7 meaning of Section 667(c) and 667(e)(1) of the California Penal
8 Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR ONE PRIOR FELONY CONVICTION THAT PROHIBITS
9 PROBATION, LIMITS CREDITS, REQUIRES CONSECUTIVE SENTENCING, AND
10 MANDATES PRISON COMMITMENT, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES was
11 convicted of a prior felony as defined in Section 667(d) of the
12 California Penal Code, and listed in Sections 667.5(c) and
13 1192.7(a) of the Penal Code, and Section 707(b) of the Welfare
14 and Institutions Code, to wit, a conviction on December 18, 1985
15 for a violation of Section 459 First Degree of the California
16 Penal Code, in the County of Yolo.

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18 Case Enhancement b : It is further alleged that ERNEST LANE
19 MORALES was previously convicted of a serious felony within the
20 meaning of Section 667(a)(1) of the California Penal Code,
21 ENHANCEMENT FOR HABITUAL CRIMINALS, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES
22 was convicted of a serious felony listed in Section 1192.7 of
23 the Penal Code, to wit, Section 459 First Degree of the
24 California Penal Code, on December 18, 1985 in the County of
25 Yolo.

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27 Case Enhancement c : It is further alleged that ERNEST LANE
28 MORALES was previously convicted of a felony within the meaning

1 of Section 667.5(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT
2 FOR PRIOR PRISON TERM, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES was convicted
3 of a felony on July 10, 2013 in the County of Yolo, and that
4 ERNEST LANE MORALES served a prison term for such conviction and
5 that ERNEST LANE MORALES has not remained free of prison custody
6 or free of a felony conviction for five years, within the
7 meaning of Section 667.5 of the Penal Code.

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9 Case Enhancement d : It is further alleged that ERNEST LANE
10 MORALES was previously convicted of a felony within the meaning
11 of Section 667.5(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT
12 FOR PRIOR PRISON TERM, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES was convicted
13 of a felony on October 2, 2012 in the County of Yolo, and that
14 ERNEST LANE MORALES served a prison term for such conviction and
15 that ERNEST LANE MORALES has not remained free of prison custody
16 or free of a felony conviction for five years, within the
17 meaning of Section 667.5 of the Penal Code.

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20 Case Enhancement e : It is further alleged that ERNEST LANE
21 MORALES was previously convicted of a felony within the meaning
22 of Section 667.5(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT
23 FOR PRIOR PRISON TERM, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES was convicted
24 of a felony on September 25, 1997 in the County of Yolo, and
25 that ERNEST LANE MORALES served a prison term for such
26 conviction and that ERNEST LANE MORALES has not remained free of
27 prison custody or free of a felony conviction for five years,
28 within the meaning of Section 667.5 of the Penal Code.

1 Case Enhancement f : It is further alleged that ERNEST LANE
2 MORALES was previously convicted of a felony within the meaning
3 of Section 667.5(b) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT
4 FOR PRIOR PRISON TERM, in that ERNEST LANE MORALES was convicted
5 of a felony on August 4, 1972 in the Federal District Court, and
6 that ERNEST LANE MORALES served a prison term for such
7 conviction and that ERNEST LANE MORALES has not remained free of
8 prison custody or free of a felony conviction for five years,
9 within the meaning of Section 667.5 of the Penal Code.
