I, the undersigned, say, on information and belief, that in  
the County of Yolo, State of California:

Count 1 : On or about October 2, 2015, JACQUELINE OCHOA  
TORRES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section  
191.5(b) of the California Penal Code, VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER  
WHILE INTOXICATED, in that JACQUELINE OCHOA TORRES did willfully  
and unlawfully kill a human being, without malice aforethought,  
while driving a vehicle, and the driving was in violation of  
Section 23140, 23152 or 23153 of the California Vehicle Code,  
and the killing was either the proximate result of the  
commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and


1 without gross negligence, and the proximate result of a lawful  
2 act which might produce death, in an unlawful manner, and  
3 without gross negligence.

4 Count 2 : On or about October 2, 2015, JACQUELINE OCHOA  
5 TORRES did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section  
6 23153(e) of the California Vehicle Code, DRIVING UNDER THE  
7 INFLUENCE OF DRUGS CAUSING INJURY, in that JACQUELINE OCHOA  
8 TORRES did willfully and unlawfully drive a vehicle while under  
9 the influence of any drug, and concurrently did any act  
10 forbidden by law and neglect a duty imposed by law in driving  
11 the vehicle, which act or neglect did proximately cause bodily  
12 injury to any person other than JACQUELINE OCHOA TORRES.

13 Count Enhancement 2a : It is further alleged that during  
14 the commission of the felony charged above, JACQUELINE OCHOA  
15 TORRES did willfully, unlawfully, and personally inflict great  
16 bodily injury upon any person, other than an accomplice, within  
17 the meaning of Section 12022.7(a) of the California Penal Code,  
18 INFLICTION OF GREAT BODILY INJURY.
